Chinese blue and white export porcelain, produced primarily during the Ming and Qing dynasties, became highly prized across Europe and the Middle East. Characterised by intricate cobalt-blue designs on a white background, these porcelains often featured motifs like dragons, floral patterns, and landscapes. Exported from the 16th to 18th centuries, they were a symbol of luxury and taste in Western markets. Their beauty, durability, and craftsmanship made them an enduring part of cross-cultural trade and artistic influence.
