Meissen porcelain, founded in 1710 in Germany, was the first European hard-paste porcelain, breaking China's monopoly. Created under the patronage of Augustus the Strong, Meissen quickly became renowned for its exceptional quality and intricate hand-painted designs. The brand's iconic blue crossed swords mark symbolises its enduring legacy in fine porcelain craftsmanship.
