The Goli Serenity mask, created by the Baule people of Côte d'Ivoire, embodies calm and wisdom. Characterized by its refined, serene expression and elegant details, this mask is used in traditional dances and ceremonies to represent ancestral spirits or deities. Its craftsmanship reflects the Baule's rich cultural and spiritual heritage.
