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Cast iron meat spikes, used historically for cooking or serving, feature a sturdy, pointed design to hold meat securely over a fire or grill. Their robust construction and practical functionality made them essential in traditional kitchens. Today, they are valued as vintage kitchen tools and collectible culinary artefacts.
