Description

A striking and highly functional 1920s Art Deco hat display stand, constructed in chrome-plated metal and iron. Tall, slender, and decisively architectural in form, it was designed for presenting hats in a millinery shop, department store, or fashion display, and now makes an exceptional decorative object in its own right.

The stand has a telescopic mechanism that adjusts from just over one metre to approximately two metres in height, allowing it to be tailored to different display settings. Its practical purpose is matched by a refined industrial elegance: the polished chrome contrasts beautifully with the darker iron structure, while the clean vertical lines and restrained geometric form reflect the streamlined aesthetic of the Art Deco period.

Originally intended to elevate and showcase hats at eye level, it would now work equally well as a sculptural display stand for a collection of vintage hats, a striking retail prop, or an unusual focal point in a dressing room, boutique, hallway, or interior with an industrial or modernist scheme.

A rare survivor from the golden age of shopfitting and visual merchandising, combining period style, adaptability, and strong decorative presence.
