Description

An enchanting Edwardian wooden nursery lamp in the form of a lighthouse, dating to circa 1910. With its charming hand-crafted character and gently whimsical design, it evokes an age when everyday objects for children were made with imagination as well as utility.

The lamp is modelled as a simple coastal beacon, its weathered timber surface and distinctive silhouette lending it the appealing character of decorative folk art. When illuminated, it gives a soft, warm glow that enhances its sculptural form rather than providing strong general lighting. It is therefore especially well suited as a decorative night light, a reassuring bedside lamp, or a playful accent in a nursery or child's bedroom.

Its maritime subject makes it a lovely addition to a coastal-inspired interior, but its appeal extends well beyond that setting. Displayed on a shelf, chest of drawers, mantelpiece, or beside a reading corner, it brings warmth, nostalgia, and a quietly evocative sense of the seaside. The timeworn surface and pleasingly naïve construction give it a personality that modern lighting rarely achieves.

A delightful and unusual early 20th-century decorative object, equally appealing to collectors of nursery antiques, folk art, and maritime-themed interiors.
