Description

Fine large Benin bronze Oba Africa bust dating to the first quarter of the 20th century. These busts were displaced on personal altars as status symbols. This one unsurprisingly is related to fertility!

These bronze artworks, created using the lost-wax casting technique, are renowned for their intricate detail and cultural significance. They symbolise royal power and are central to the rich artistic heritage of Benin.
