The Cammei design has been used on a multitude of Fornasetti pieces: from teacups and other ceramic pieces to trays and screens, and proved a hit on tabletops.

Fornasetti is an iconic Italian design house renowned for its distinctive and whimsical aesthetic. Founded by Piero Fornasetti in the mid-20th century, the brand is celebrated for its imaginative use of classical motifs, particularly the face of opera singer Lina Cavalieri, which has become a recurring theme. Fornasetti's designs span various mediums, including furniture, ceramics, and textiles, often featuring surreal, trompe-l'œil elements. Today, Piero's son, Barnaba Fornasetti, continues the legacy, blending traditional craftsmanship with innovative design. The brand remains a symbol of artistic elegance, merging functional objects with timeless, imaginative artistry.
