Description

An Edwardian 9ct rose gold necklace set with Almandine garnets and white sapphires, circa 1915

Almandine garnets are a deep red to brownish-red variety of garnet, prized for their rich color and durability. They are composed of iron aluminium silicate and belong to the isometric crystal system, often forming dodecahedral or trapezohedral crystals.

Almandines are commonly found in metamorphic rocks, such as schist and gneiss. These gemstones symbolise strength and passion, frequently used in jewellery. T
