Description

A bold and elegant French Retro ring, crafted in heavy 18ct yellow gold and dating to circa 1940. The design is centred on a single old mine-cut diamond, its softly rounded, hand-cut facets giving it a distinctive antique brilliance. Smaller rose-cut diamonds provide a subtle, glittering accent, complementing the central stone without detracting from its character.

The diamonds are set above a richly textured reeded shank, a sculptural detail that gives the ring its strong period presence. The generous yellow-gold setting and confident form are characteristic of the French Retro style, which favoured dramatic silhouettes, warm gold tones, and expressive, architectural design.

A beautifully wearable example of mid-century French jewellery, combining the charm of historic-cut diamonds with the glamour and substance of the 1940s. Its substantial construction and unusual textured band make it an especially appealing choice for collectors of Retro jewellery or for anyone seeking a distinctive diamond ring with genuine period character.
