Unlike pile rugs, kilims have no knotted surface, making them thinner and more lightweight. Traditionally woven by hand, these rugs often carry symbolic motifs representing protection, fertility, or prosperity. Kilims serve both functional and decorative purposes, used as floor coverings, wall hangings, or furniture throws. Today, they are valued for their artistry, cultural significance, and timeless aesthetic appeal.
