Joseph Josiah Dodd (1853-1938) was an influential American artist known for his vibrant landscapes and genre scenes. Active during the late 19th and early 20th centuries, he often depicted rural life, capturing the beauty of nature with a keen eye for detail and colour. Dodd studied at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts and became associated with the New Hope School, which emphasized Impressionist techniques. His works reflect a deep appreciation for the landscape, earning him recognition in the art community.
