Description

18th century Rouen faience black-bottom tin-glazed blue and white pottery platter, stapled, circa 1750-1780.

Black-bottomed Rouen faience refers to a type of French earthenware from the Rouen region, distinguished by its dark, glossy glaze on the base. Originating in the 17th century, it often features intricate, colourful designs on the upper surfaces. This unique contrast highlights the craftsmanship and artistic innovation of Rouen pottery.
