Lowboys are small, low-profile chests of drawers, typically featuring three to four drawers and short legs. Originating in the 18th century, particularly in colonial America and England, they were often used as dressing tables. Known for their elegant craftsmanship, lowboys blend practicality with decorative, ornate detailing.
