Baguette cut diamonds are rectangular-shaped with straight, linear facets that emphasise clarity and brilliance. Originating in the 1920s Art Deco era, this cut creates a sleek, elegant look. Often used as side stones or in channel settings, baguette diamonds complement larger stones, adding sophisticated detail and geometric harmony to jewellery.
