Description

An exquisite Edwardian Belle Époque natural seed pearl necklace, dating to circa 1910. Delicate, luminous, and beautifully understated, this refined jewel captures the graceful femininity and exceptional workmanship associated with the finest jewellery of the early 20th century.

The necklace is composed of closely graduated natural seed pearls, each selected for its gentle lustre and softly iridescent surface. Their subtle variation in tone and size gives the piece a pleasing organic character, while the fine stringing creates an elegant line around the neck. A white-gold clasp provides a discreet and secure finish, chosen to complement the cool, silvery palette of the pearls.

Jewels of this type were highly prized during the Belle Époque, when natural pearls represented the height of refinement and were central to the fashionable jewellery wardrobe. Worn alone, this necklace offers an elegant, timeless statement; layered with other pearl strands, it brings authentic Edwardian sophistication to a more contemporary look.

A romantic and increasingly rare survivor from the period, ideal for collectors of antique jewellery, lovers of natural pearls, or as an exceptional heirloom piece for bridal and special-occasion wear.
