Description

A pair of large white enamel Benjamin pendant lamps circa 1950.

Rewired with chrome fittings and black fabric twisted flex. PAT tested.

Produced by the Benjamin Electric Manufacturing Company, founded by Reuben Berkley Benjamin in Chicago, Illinois in 1898. With the popularity of its lighting, the company expanded rapidly throughout the USA and Canada and then finally abroad, to England - more specifically London - which is where our shades were manufactured.

Known for their durable, utilitarian design, these shades made from enamel-coated steel, often seen in factories, warehouses, and workshops. The shades typically feature a wide, flared shape that directs light downward, making them highly functional. Today, Benjamin lamp shades are valued for their vintage, industrial aesthetic and are popular in interior design, adding a retro, timeless feel to modern spaces.
