Description

A handsome set of six silver-plated wine goblets by Elkington & Co., dating from circa 1900. Elegantly proportioned and finely made, each goblet is engraved with a family crest, giving the set both a distinguished decorative presence and a personal sense of history.

The goblets have graceful bowls raised on slender stems and circular spreading feet, their bright silver-plated finish lending a polished, formal character to the table. The engraved crest provides a subtle focal point to each piece, transforming an already refined service into an especially evocative set for entertaining, dining, or display.

Elkington & Co. was among the leading British makers of silver plate in the 19th and early 20th centuries. Celebrated for the quality of its workmanship and the sophistication of its designs, the firm supplied fashionable households, hotels, and institutions throughout Britain and beyond. This set reflects that heritage, combining practicality with the enduring elegance of turn-of-the-century English tableware.

Ideal for serving wine at a formal dinner, celebration, or festive gathering, these goblets would also make a refined addition to a dining-room sideboard or a collection of antique silver plate.
