Asparagus tongs, developed in the 18th century, were designed specifically for serving asparagus with elegance and ease. Originating in Europe, these tongs feature long, slender arms and a scalloped or serrated design to grasp delicate asparagus spears without damaging them.

Their introduction reflected the period's emphasis on refined dining and proper etiquette. Over time, asparagus tongs became a staple in formal settings, symbolising sophistication and attention to culinary presentation.
