Having a boarded top, a pair of boarded doors each carved with a dragon within applied deep gauged and punch-decorated frame rails, centred by stiff leaf upright atop lunette-carved and cusp-edged aprons centred by a pendant, above an open under tier, on slender parallel-baluster over reel-turned front legs, a cable carved and crenellated lower edge base rail
