## Description

The face comprising a panel of fine cotton gauze embroidered in brightly coloured silks and metallic thread with a stylised floral design historically applied to a 19th century cotton velvet and edged with a slender woven silk braid, the whole edged with a silk fringed braid, 19th century silk velvet back, filled with 100% British wool and sewn closed

Our cushions are the epitome of sustainable home decor. Made from worn or imperfect antique textiles which might otherwise have been lost but which remain beautiful and worthy of re-imagining in less traditional ways. We clean and repair highly attractive fragments from our extensive collection to form covers and fill them with pure British wool which is more allergy friendly than feathers and also helps support the UK wool industry
