Description

All worked in coloured wools on a linen twill ground, using a variety of stitches, designed with foliate and floral branches to represent a 'tree of life', the hillocky ground to the bottom with a bounding stag, the embroidery typically historically re-applied retaining elements of the original ground, (4)
