Description

This fabulous antique French mirrored silver plateau was made by the great Parisian silversmiths, Maison Odier, employing 1st standard French silver (950/1000). The plateau is of exceptional quality with finely cast detail of laurel leaves and berries on a textured background and laurel leaf borders above and below.

A special table centrepiece in its own right, the plateau would be also be perfect dressed with a large silver jardinière or épergne centrepiece. The mirrored glass is 945 mm x 480 mm (37" x 19").

In the 19th century, French inventive and skilled silversmiths, such as Odier, created eclectic and exceptional pieces. Founded by Jean-Baptiste Claude Odier - silversmith to Napoleon - Odier Maison was almost certainly the most renowned and celebrated French silver manufacturer of the time. During the 19th century, under the guide of his grandson, Jean-Baptiste Gustave Odier, the firm supplied silverware to the principal European royal families and won prizes for exceptional exhibition pieces presented on the international stage.
