


Hand hammered Arts & Crafts silver bowl on a copper stand

Description

A truly interesting hand-hammered Arts & Crafts silver bowl with handmade copper frame, from the Edwardian era. Both silver bowl and base are hand hammered.

A beautiful and decorative example of the the Arts & Crafts style, this bowl could be used to serve nuts or sweets and the weight given is for the silver bowl only.

The Arts & Crafts movement emerged from a disenchantment with the impersonal, mechanised direction of society in the 19th century, and sought to return to a simpler, more fulfilling way of living. The movement was admired for its use of high quality materials and for its emphasis on utility in design.
