Description

An Edwardian sterling silver teapot of most unusual design featuring Art Nouveau influences. The flared, drum-shaped body features panels of interesting embossed lattice decorations and is mounted on four feet. Each side shows a plain scroll-bordered cartouche.

This charming silver teapot is fitted a scrolling handle with heat insulators, and a hinged fluted lid surmounted by an ivory finial. It's a perfect size for three cups of your favourite tea.

Note: Under the rules of the UK government's Ivory Act 2018, this silver teapot qualifies for an ivory exemption certificate. If required, the ivory parts may be replicated and replaced with an ivory substitute at no additional cost.
