Description

First designed by Johan Rohde in 1915, this sterling silver coffee pot, called Cosmos, was crafted in Denmark by silversmith Georg Jensen after 1945. This piece is entirely handmade with cast detail and a carved fluted wooden handle.

Before becoming a designer for the studio, Johan Rohde (1856-1935) was impressed by the craftsmanship of Georg Jensen. Their first association was in 1904, when Rohde commissioned Georg Jensen to make some objects for his own personal use. This collaboration was a great success for both sides. Starting in 1906, Johan Rohde designed serene, elegant products for the silversmith, Jensen. Rohde's designs have much in common with the designs of Georg Jensen himself and are symbols of a remarkable era in 20th century design.
